

State Impact

It is not known how many applicants for ID cards and drivers licenses using ITIN numbers are here in the state illegally. Therefore it is estimated that provisions of this bill could reduce state revenues from ID cards and driver license applicants using ITIN numbers by up to \$554,000 in FY 2005 and up to \$593,500 in FY 2006.
