

State Impact

Provisions of the bill appropriate \$7,500,000 in one-time General Fund revenue to support the Basic Skills Education Stipend Program outlined in the bill. The State Board of Education may use up to \$200,000 of this revenue for program administration. The bill further provides for an appropriation of \$12,500,000 in one-time Uniform School Fund revenue to support the Grades 4-6 Mathematics Improvement program outlined in the bill.

Individual and Business Impact
