

State Impact

It is estimated that provisions of this bill will increase General Fund revenues by \$2,400 in FY 2006 and \$14,400 each fiscal year thereafter. The Courts will require General Fund appropriations of \$4,500 in FY 2006 and \$27,000 each fiscal year thereafter to deal with the increased caseload.
