State Impact

Enactment of this bill will require additional appropriations of approximately \$859,000 in FY 2009 and \$936,000 in FY 2010. The FY 2009 appropriation is \$172,000 General Fund and \$687,000 Federal Funds. The FY 2010 appropriation is \$187,000 General Fund and \$749,000 Federal Funds. Costs in the future may decrease because of potential competition between an increased number of ambulatory surgical center providers.
