State Impact

Enactment of this bill could result in a General Fund loss of \$108,000 in FY 2009 and a loss of \$1,026,000 in FY 2010. The bill also appropriates \$4,250,000 to the Cigarette Tax Restricted Account for cancer screening, Gold Medal Schools program, and tobacco prevention, reduction, cessation, and control programs.
