State Impact

Enactment of this bill will require an appropriation of \$300 on-going from the Commerce Service Fund to pay per-diem for an additional board member. It may also result in decreased revenue to the Commerce Service Fund of \$200 in FY 2009 and \$1,000 in FY 2010 due fewer people registering with the Department of Commerce, Division of Occupational Licensing. The net impact on the General Fund of these Commerce Service Fund changes is lost revenue of \$500 in FY 2009 and \$1,300 in FY 2010.
