State Impact

Enactment of this bill requires an estimated \$273,600 ongoing from the Uniform School Fund appropriated to the State Board of Education in support of the State Capital Facility Board created in this bill. Estimates include an additional 3 full-time equivalent employees, per diem for board members, and expenses incurred in the performance of the Board's official duties.

Individual, Business and/or Local Impact

Enactment of this bill may alter the capital facility construction and renovation procedures used by school districts and charter schools. Bill provisions require that the local education entity provide one dollar in matching funds for every four dollars received in state funding.
