State Impact

Enactment of this bill will create the Firefighter Support Restricted Account. The amount of revenue going into the fund depends upon the number of individuals paying at least \$15 to support the fund. If 80 percent of the individuals that currently have a firefighter recognition plate decide to participate, revenue to the fund would be \$113,000. The costs associated with reordering special group license plates and replacing special group license plates with new license plates will be paid by the Firefighter Support Restricted Account.
