Individuals who are not in this country legally and currently receiving state services would not lose those services until FY 2011. Local Health Departments could delay expanding their workforces to determine citizenship and eligibility until FY 2011. Business that may incur additional costs associated with administering payroll and withholding taxes would not realize those costs until FY 2011.
