**State Impact**

Enactment of this bill will have an ongoing net General Fund cost of \$4,300. The Courts will require \$8,600 in ongoing General Funds for increased workload costs. The bill generates \$4,300 in ongoing General Fund revenue and \$4,300 in restricted fund revenue. This bill may impact the Attorney General in litigation costs.
