State Impact

If 500 individuals donate \$25 each year under the provisions of this bill, revenue to the Utah High School Rodeo Support Restricted Account could be \$12,500 annually. If 1,000 individuals participate in the program (500 per year), dedicated credits for license plate production would be \$2,000 and revenue to the Transportation Fund would be \$500 annually. Startup costs are paid from private sources.
