State Impact

Enactment of this bill will require an ongoing appropriation of \$34,000 per year from the General Fund beginning FY 2011. The bill will generate dedicated credits of approximately \$30,000 annually beginning FY 2011, \$10,000 of which will cover card issuer costs and \$20,000 of which shall be used for Search and Rescue Financial Assistance.
