Provisions of this bill reduce sales tax revenue to the Centennial Highway Fund Restricted Account by \$113,000,000 and increases revenue to the General Fund one-time by \$113,000,000 in FY 2011. Expenditures from the Centennial Highway Fund Program would decreased by \$113,000,000 one-time in FY 2011.
