State Government (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will cost the State Tax Commission \$20,000 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2012 for modifications to the State's online vehicle registration systems.

Local Governments (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill will require 4 counties to implement an emissions inspection and maintenance program. These counties are: Cache, Box Elder, Tooele, and Summit. The counties will incur start-up costs. However, once emission inspections are implemented, counties may charge fees to help offset costs.

Direct Expenditures by Utah Residents and Businesses (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Individuals in counties that will be required to establish new emissions inspections and maintenance programs will be charged fees for inspections.
