## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enacting this bill may increase claims to the State health insurance risk pool up to \$350,000 annually and may increase the State's premium. Any savings to the Medicaid program for those currently covered and possibly shifting to private insurance would negligible.
