## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will reduce per diem and travel costs in the Department of Environmental Quality by reducing the number of board members. Total cost reductions are estimated at \$11,800 per year ongoing as follows: General Fund: \$5,300; Federal Funds: \$1,300; and Restricted Funds: \$5,200.
