STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could cost the Department of Health an estimated \$221,200 federal funds in FY 2012 and \$73,700 federal funds in FY 2013 to develop the technical infrastructure of a public health Master Person Index. The Department of Health already has a grant to pay for these costs.
