## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could reduce the amounts collected by PEHP from audit findings by up to \$65,000 per year attributable to the state risk pool. Reduced collections could result in lower fund balances. To the extent that fund balances reduce rates, state costs could be impacted.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

To the extent that lower audit findings impact fund balances and rates, local governments could experience benefits cost increases.

## DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable expenditures by Utah residents or businesses.
