Enactment of this bill will result ongoing General Fund savings of \$392,000 beginning in FY 2013, offset by \$378,600 in one-time General Fund costs to implement the bill's provisions. State savings will result in federal fund reductions of \$460,200 in FY 2013 and \$818,600 in FY 2014.
