## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enacting this bill will likely cost the state \$195,000 ongoing from various funds for health insurance premiums. The bill may cost public education about \$165,000 from the Education Fund presuming the state pays this cost. It will also cost the Insurance Department about \$6,700 one-time from the Insurance Department Restricted Account to review plans and rules. Insurance Department Restricted Account revenues and expenditures affect the annual transfer to the General Fund.
