

# FISCAL NOTE

H.B. 477

SHORT TITLE: Employment and Verification Requirements

SPONSOR: Sandstrom, S.

## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will cost the Attorney General approximately \$222 per case for investigations and cost the Courts \$207 to process each finding. Assuming that complaints are filed for 1 in every 100 illegal immigrant workers, Attorney General total costs will be \$257,400 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2013. If 50% of these complaints are processed by the Courts, total costs will be \$120,100 from the General Fund for a total ongoing cost of \$377,500.

For each hour of hiring training required in this bill, the Attorney General will generate an estimated \$50 per hour in costs and revenue beginning in FY 2013, however the total amount of training hours is unknown at this time.
