SHORT TITLE: College and Career Readiness Assessment

SPONSOR: Dayton, M.

2012 GENERAL SESSION

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill appropriates \$2,200,000 ongoing from the Education Fund to the State Board of Education to implement college and career readiness assessments.

The Utah State Office of Education currently has \$1,500,000 in ongoing funding to support the Utah Basic Skills Competency Test (UBSCT). Provisions outlined in this bill eliminate the UBSCT, generating a cost savings. The net cost of enacting testing requirements of this bill is estimated at \$700,000.
