STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enacting this bill will result in ongoing court, incarceration, and supervision costs of \$62,400 in FY 2014 and \$122,400 in FY 2015 from the General Fund. Costs will increase each year until FY 2018 when ongoing costs from the General Fund will be \$219,900. General Fund revenue collections from criminal penalties will be approximately \$1,000 annually for a net General Fund cost of \$61,400 in FY 2014 and \$121,400 in FY 2015.
