SHORT TITLE: Anesthesiologist Assistant Amendments

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill would increase revenue to the Commerce Service Fund by \$900 in FY 2014 and by \$1,500 in FY 2015. Costs to the Commerce Department for implementation of the provisions of the bill would be \$7,200 one-time from the Commerce Service Fund in FY 2014 and \$800 ongoing beginning in FY 2015. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund affects annual transfers to the General Fund.

An estimated 5 individuals will apply for the \$180 license established in the bill resulting in a cumulative cost of \$900. An estimated 5 individual will renew in year two at a cost of \$123 for an additional cumulative cost of about \$600.
