## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could increase costs to the Department of Commerce by \$22,400 ongoing and by \$14,000 one-time beginning in FY 2014. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund affects annual transfers to the General Fund.
