Enactment of this bill appropriates \$200,000 ongoing from the Education Fund for costs associated with the development and implementation of instruction in lifesaving emergency procedures.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill allocates \$200,000 for costs associated with the development and implementation of instruction in lifesaving emergency procedures, about \$170,000 of which would cover professional development costs of local education agencies.
