STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will increase General Fund revenue by approximately \$2,800 every even numbered year through fines levied on political party candidates who fail to file a proper financial disclosure report on time.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Every even numbered year, political party candidates who are required to be certified by a political party and who fail to file a proper financial disclosure report on time will be fined \$500. All other candidates will be fined \$100 for failure to file a proper financial disclosure report on time.

PERFORMANCE NOTE (JR 4-2-404): Not Required
