## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

This bill eliminates the Utah Basic Skills Competency Test which costs \$1,500,000 to run, and replaces it with the Utah Performance Assessment System for Students (U-PASS) which costs \$2,200,000 to run. The bill appropriates the \$700,000 difference from the Education Fund to the State Board of Education.
