STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Implementation of this bill could cost the Office of the Attorney General an estimated \$700,000 per year from the General Fund to hire additional staff. The Legislative General Counsel has attached a Constitutional Note to this bill. If provisions in this bill are challenged in court, there will be additional costs associated with defending those provisions.
