LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill could cost some Local Education Agencies up to \$20,000 per instance to install new fire supression systems and remove underground storage tanks. There could also be savings for some Local Education Agencies up to \$15,000 per instance for waivers related to Emergency Responder Radio Coverage.

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable expenditures by Utah residents or businesses.
