DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Parents or legal guardians of about 12,230 applicable sixth graders may see an average fee increase of about \$20 per child, or up to \$244,600 in total.
