DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

By including nicotine products in the categories covered under the cigarette and tobacco criminal provisions, including provisions related to advertising, selling to minors, and the manner in which nicotine products are sold, enactment of this bill increases fine charges to individuals by approximately \$9,600 in FY 2014 and \$9,800 in FY 2015.
