STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will increase expenditures from the General Fund by about \$54,900 beginning in FY 2014. These costs result from the increased workload shifted to the appeals board of the Labor Commission to review and decide appeals.
