SHORT TITLE: Food Handler Licensing Amendments

2013 GENERAL SESSION

## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill likely will not materially impact the state budget.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

## DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Some residents will need to renew food handler permits every two years instead of three. Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable expenditures by businesses.
