STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enacting this bill may increase collections from fraud and waste for the Medicaid program in third-party liability cases by approximately \$7 million per year beginning in FY 2014. That \$7 million is approximately \$2 million General Fund, and \$5 million federal Medicaid funds.
