This bill costs the state approximately \$29,800 ongoing General Fund and \$70,200 federal funds beginning in FY 2014 to buy insurance to cover the costs of a data breach for the state's health care providers within the Departments of Health and Human Services who have provider agreements with Medicaid and have received at least \$50,000 in payment from Medicaid in the preceding 12 months.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

All health care providers who have provider agreements with Medicaid and have received at least \$50,000 in payment from Medicaid in the preceding 12 months may have to buy insurance to cover the costs of a data breach.
