STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill appropriates \$3,000,000 one-time from the Education Fund in FY 2014 to the State Board of Education to implement the one to one mobile device technology pilot program in selected schools as outlined in the bill.
