## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

This bill appropriates \$200,000 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2015 to the Division of Air Quality. Funds would be used on approved grants to implement clean air technologies for vehicles and equipment.

Grants will be made available to individuals for eligible projects. Grant amounts are limited to 50% of the cost of the conversion equipment or 50% of the incremental cost of the original manufacturer equipment (OEM) vehicle.
