STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill likely will not materially impact the state budget.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Implementation of this bill will likely cost \$905,400 one-time in FY 2015 to all K-12 schools for the purchases of carbon monoxide detection, with average cost per school of \$852. Additional cost may include electrical supplies and labor.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable expenditures by Utah residents or businesses.
