STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill allocates Education Fund revenue surplus, if any, up to \$25 million, to the newly created Capital Outlay Account.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill allocates Education Fund revenue surplus, if any, up to \$25 million, to the Capital Outlay Account, which is distributed 50/50 to the Capital Outlay Enrollment Growith and Capital Outlay Foundation programs. Should \$25 million be distributed according to the two programs, a receiving district may receive between \$10,000 and \$8,160,000.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable expenditures by Utah residents or businesses.
