## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

The bill could generate one-time revenue for the General Fund of \$400 in FY 2014 and \$2,600 in FY 2015. Between FY 2017 and FY 2018 the bill could generate about \$2,000 one-time.

About 100 businesses paying for a license to sell electronic cigarette products will pay \$30 from FY 2014 through FY 2015. Ongoing about 100 business will pay \$20 every three years to renew their licenses.
