Enactment of this bill could increase revenue to the Commerce Service Fund by \$3,000 annually as revenue is generated from the certified copies provided. Costs to the Commerce Department to provide certified copies and answer inquiries could be \$5,100 annually. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund affects annual transfers to the General Fund.
