## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could create additional workload for:

- 1.Courts \$1,331,100 for judge/clerk time and jury expenses,
- 2.Attorney General \$950,200 for attorney representation, and
- 3. Guardian ad Litem \$787,400 for attorney representation

Totaling \$3,068,700 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2015.

In addition, enactment of this bill may cost the Guardian ad Litem about \$33,000 one-time from the General Fund for office equipment.

This bill may also generate about \$36,000 in ongoing General Fund revenue.
