STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could increase license revenue to the Commerce Service Fund by \$3,800 annually. Costs to the Department of Commerce to process registrations and investigate potential complaints could be \$8,000 annually.
