STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could forgo tax revenue from out-of-state companies and individuals when disasters/emergencies are declared.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Due to the sales tax exemption, local taxing entities could forgo sales tax revenue from out-of-state companies when disasters/emergencies are declared.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Individuals and businesses could see a decrease in tax liability when doing disaster work during declared emergencies.
