STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could cost the Division of Water Rights \$52,300 one-time in FY 2015 and \$16,300 ongoing from the General Fund in FY 2016 for programming and additional part-time staff.
