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**Purpose:** Utah Code 19-1-403. Clean Fuels and Vehicle Technology Fund -- Contents -- Loans or grants made with fund money, provides authority and policy direction to the Department of Environmental Quality to develop and implement programs to promote the adoption o

**Services:** The Department of Environmental Quality will make administrative rules that implement the statute changes. Accounting systems will be developed to track and process payments to grant and loan recipients. Application forms will be developed and processed for the new grants and loans and continued to be processed for the tax rebate programs. Record keeping will be coordinated with the Utah State Tax Commission.

**Expected Outcome:** The adoption of clean fuel vehicle technology will result in fewer emissions for each vehicle mile traveled. The incentive programs will encourage the purchase of clean fuel vehicles and will encourage manufacturers to produce additional vehicles and equipment.

**Implementations and Resources:** The Department of Environmental Quality will employ # full-time equivalent (FTE) for each year that funding is available for the programs.

**How:** Administrative rules will be modified to implement the new program requirements. New accounting and application forms will be developed. The Clean Fuel Vehicle Technology website will be updated and will serve as a repository for the program forms, policies and procedures. Applications that meet the program requirements will be processed and grants, loans or tax form approvals (TC40V) will be provided.
