This bill appropriates \$750,000 one-time from the Education Fund in FY 2016 and \$47,500,000 ongoing and \$24,250,000 one-time from the Education Fund beginning in FY 2017 to the State Board of Education to use on a digital teaching and learning grant program. It also appropriates \$500,000 ongoing and \$23,000,000 one-time beginning in FY 2017 to the Utah Education and Telehealth Network to use on the digital teaching and learning grant program.

This bill allows local education agencies to receive grants for digital teaching and learning plans approved by the State Board of Education. The bill appropriates up to \$69,500,000 in total grants for FY 2017 and up to \$45,250,000 in total for grants in fiscal years 2018 and beyond.
