**Purpose:** The purpose and duties of the new program are to establish a program to provide women's health education classes within correctional facilities for women in state and county custody.

**Services:** The service provided by the funding increase are outlined line 55-94.

**Expected Outcome:** The expected outcome of the program will be to develop a two week course, which includes 10 modules covering the topics outlined lines 70 - 75.

**Implementations and Resources:** The bill will be implemented by the Utah Department of Health in partnership with the Utah Department of Corrections.

**How:** The proposed activities will cause an increase in the level of education, attitudes, and beliefs regarding women's health including reproductive life planning, contraception, disease prevention and treatment, and information regarding available community services for women's health.
