Enactment of this bill could cost a total of \$90,800 from the General Fund in FY 2018, \$181,500 in FY 2019, and \$227,500 each year thereafter. This assumes a total of about 3 new prisoners each year until FY 2020 when the total increased prisoner count reaches a constant state of 7.5 additional prisoners and presumes an average length of stay of 2.5 years. The cost breakdown is as follows:

1. Department of Corrections - \$89,100 in FY 2018, \$178,100 in FY 2019, and \$222,700 each year thereafter for incarceration costs; and, 2. Board of Pardons and Parole - \$1,700 in FY 2018, \$3,400 in FY 2019, and \$4,200 each year thereafter for additional hearings.
